In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 65 read with Sections 32, 38 & 40 of the IVC Act, 1959, the Government of Goa had notified the Rules for the Goa State Veterinary Council vide Notification No. 14-2-82-AH dated 22nd November, 1990.

As per Rule 3 above, the persons enrolled in the Goa State Veterinary Register maintained under Chapter VII of the Act are required to elect four members from among themselves to the State Veterinary Council under clause (a) of sub-section (1) of Section 32, of the IVC Act, 1959.
